

# **Logan City School District Elementary School Choice 2010-2011**

## **For Families/Students currently on School Choice to an Elementary School**

- Families/students at a school through school choice prior to the boundary changes may remain at that school as long as the agreements made with the school are still being met.

## **For Families/Students currently in school who would be moving to a new school and want to stay**

- Families/students affected by a boundary change that desire to return to their former school should apply for school choice by March 19, 2010.
- Principals will meet to discuss all school choice candidates and agree to assignments prior to full-time equivalent (FTE) meetings for 2010-11.
- Students applying for school choice after March will be considered by principals on a case by case basis after full-time equivalent (FTE) meetings for 2010-11.
- Elementary school principals consider classes full for school choice considerations at 22 students for lower grade classes and 25-26 students for upper grade classes.

## **Kindergarten School Choice**

- At registration Kindergarten students are to be placed in their own school first.
- Kindergarten students will also be moved at the principals meeting discussed above in bullet #3.
- Kindergarten students will not be granted school choice solely on a desire for optional extended-day kindergarten (OEK).
- Kindergarten readiness students will attend their home school even if school choice is being considered.
- Principals will receive a form from kindergarten registrations that will include:
  - Students assigned to our school at registration.
  - Students who would come to a school if school choice is granted.
  - Students who will go back to a school if school choice is not granted.
- Otherwise kindergarten students will be treated like all other school choice students.
