Primary responsibility will be collaborating with educators, providing guidance and resources to enhance instructional practices and meet the diverse needs of EL students.

- 2. Detailed cover letter outlining special competencies related to and specific interest in the particular position
- 3. Current resume in which professional preparation and experience are clearly detailed
- 4. Three letters of recommendation written within the last six months
- 5. Transcripts of all college and university credits
- 6. Student teaching or most recent evaluation

- Collaborate with educators to develop and implement instructional strategies that support ELs in achieving academic success
- Provide ongoing professional development and coaching to educators on best practices for language acquisition and differentiation

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- Conduct classroom observations and provide constructive feedback to educators on their instructional delivery and support strategies
- Develop and maintain resources, materials, and tools to assist educators in effectively scaffolding content for ELs
- Stay abreast of current research, trends, and best practices in EL instruction and integrate them into coaching sessions and professional development activities
- Collaborate with other stakeholders, such as administrators and instructional coaches, to ensure alignment of EL support initiatives with school-wide goals and standards
- Maintain accurate records of EL forms and paperwork
- Participate in ongoing professional development opportunities to enhance coaching skills and expertise

Requirements:

- Valid Professional Educator License with an EL Endorsement
- Proven experience working with EL students in an educational setting
- Strong understanding of language acquisition theories and best practices for EL instruction
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to effectively collaborate with diverse groups of educators
- Demonstrated ability to provide constructive feedback and support to educators in improving their instructional practices
